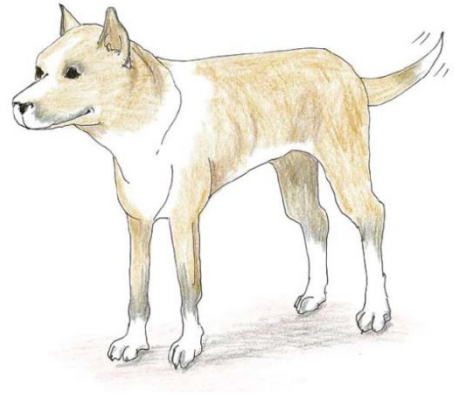


Dogs' Feelings

Happy

Happy dogs might:

- be relaxed
- wag their tails
- smile or pant.



Angry

Angry dogs might:

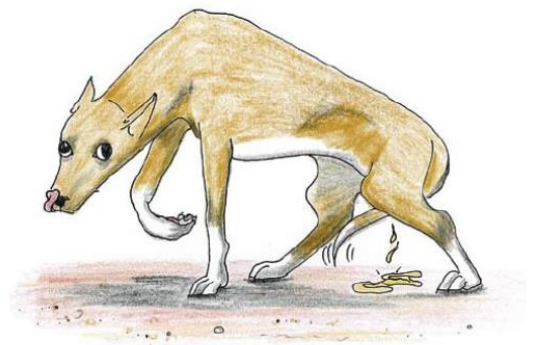
- show their teeth
- growl or bark
- have hair stick up on the back of their necks (hackles)
- stand stiff.



Scared

Scared dogs might:

- crouch down
- hide their tails between their legs
- show the whites of their eyes
- clamp their ears to their heads.



We need to learn how to read dogs' feelings so we can stay safe around dogs. Keep away from angry and scared dogs: they might bite. Ask before you pat happy dogs.
