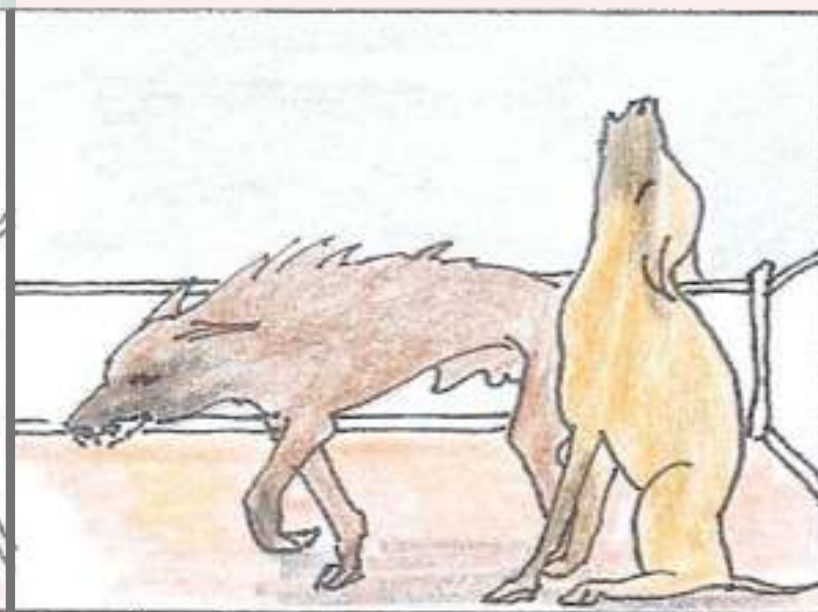


# Desexed dogs

# Dogs that can breed

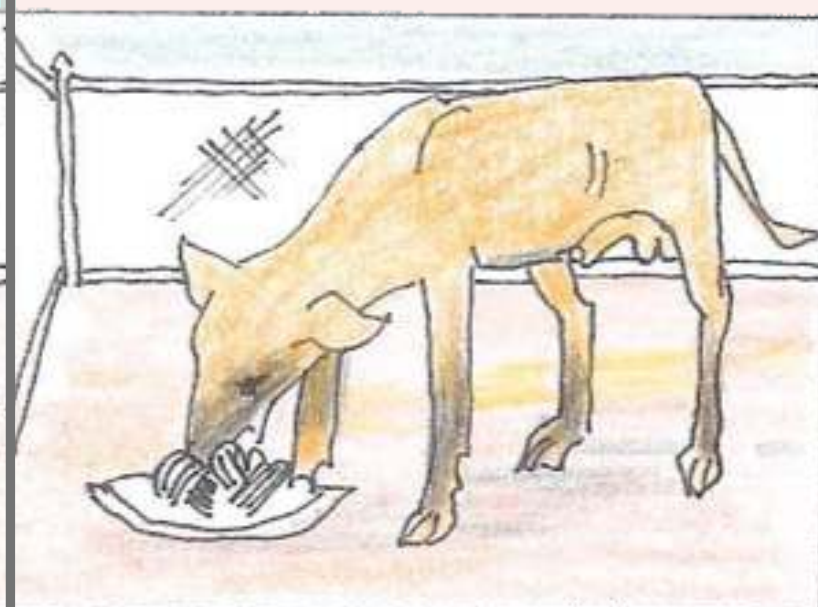
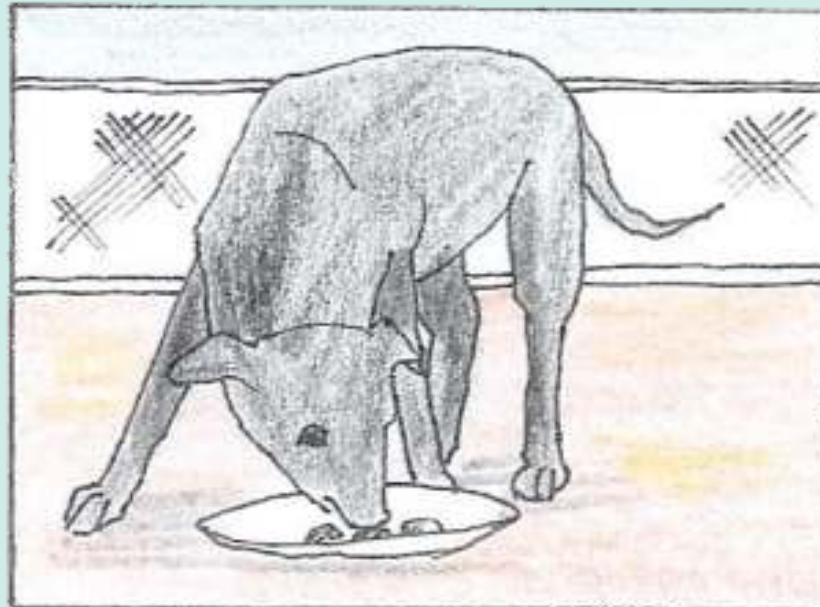
Desexed dogs are better pets

They also cause more humbug

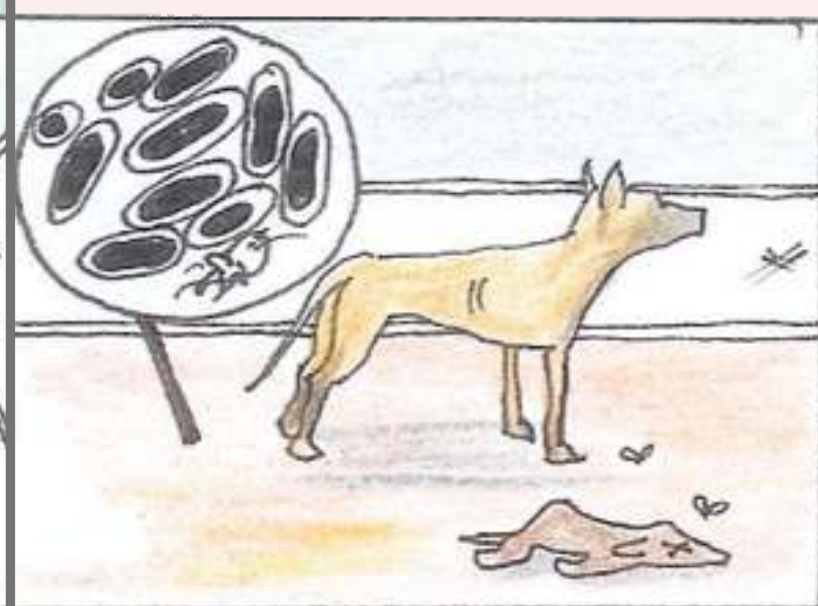
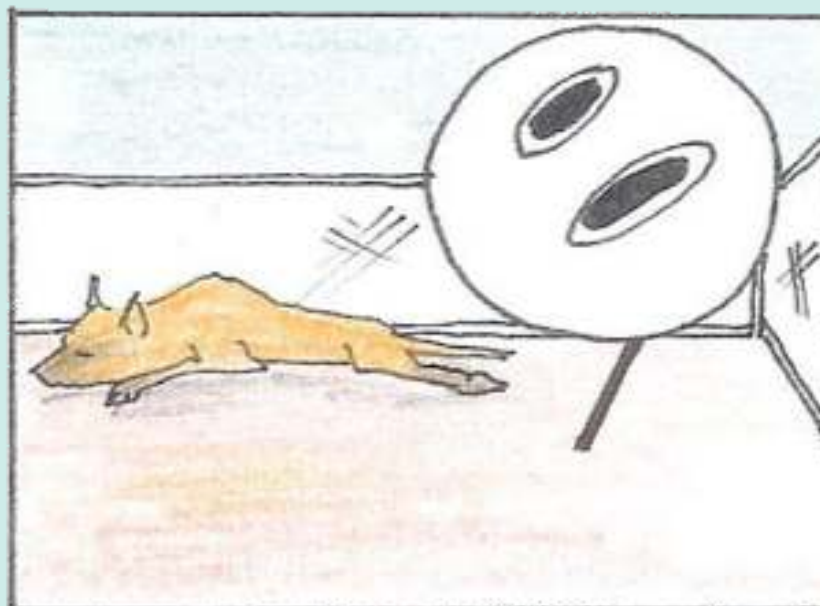
Desexed dogs eat less and stay fatter



Breeding dogs need more food

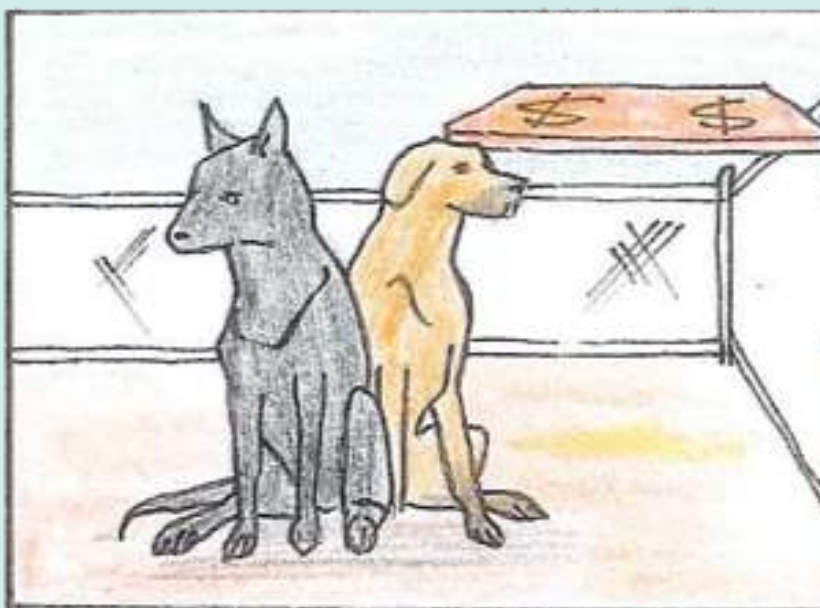
Desexed dogs have less germs and worms

This means less germs in the yard



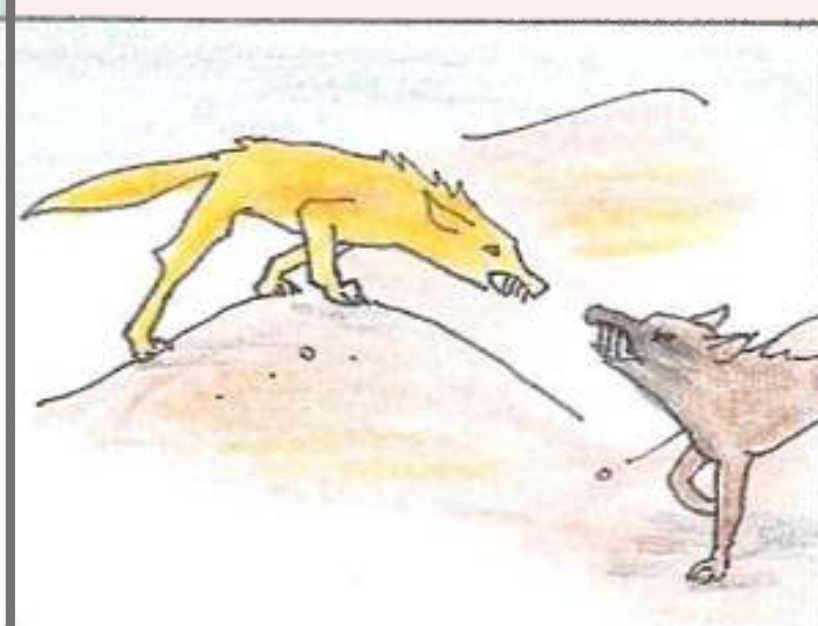
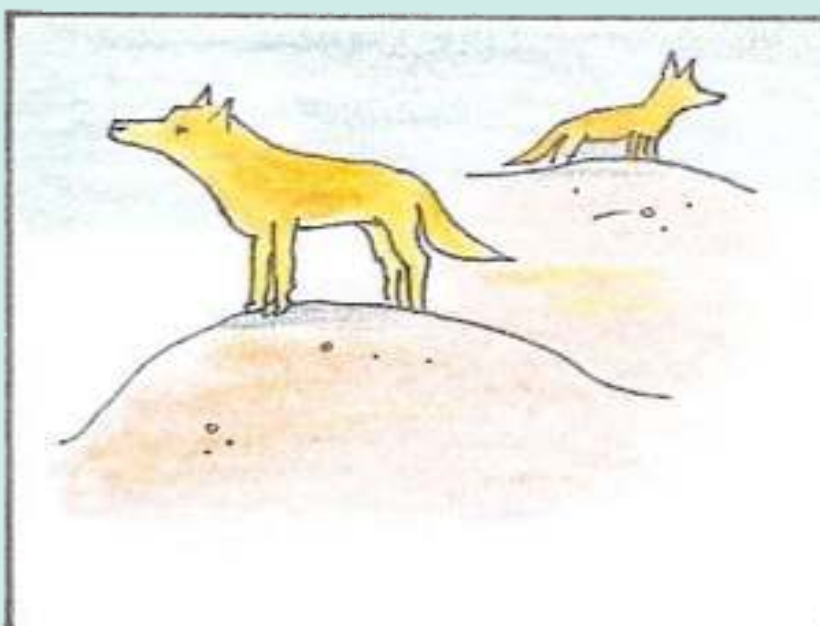
Breeding dogs and their pups put lots of germs into yards
