Resource Overview	
Year Level	Years 10- Adult
Pre-requisite Knowledge (optional)	Before engaging with this resource, it could be helpful for viewers to understand what a tick is and how it operates, i.e. ticks need to feed on a living host to survive. Additionally, it could be beneficial for viewers to have basic knowledge on diseases and germs and how these affect individuals, animals and the broader community.

# 4 Ways to Stop TICK SICKNESS



Stop your dog getting tick sickness (Ehrlichiosis)



**1. Use a good tick collar like Kiltix or Seresto.**



**2. Give dogs regular medicine like Nexgard or Bravecto.**



**3. Keep your grass nice and short and keep dogs away from bushy areas**



**4. Speak to housing mob and get your house sprayed for ticks.**
