


WHAT IS IT?

Cryptosporidiosis is a sickness with diarrhoea and stomach cramps caused by the parasite Cryptosporidium parvum

WHY IS THIS PARASITE A PROBLEM?

It is the most common waterborne disease in Australia



Infection rates are 50x higher in Indigenous communities compared to non-Indigenous

communities

TREATMENT

If you are sick, talk to your doctor to see if you need special medicine

Be sure to drink lots of water to prevent dehydration

PREVENTION

Wash your hands after toileting or handling animals

Don't allow pets to drink dirty water

Water should be filtered or boiled before drinking
