

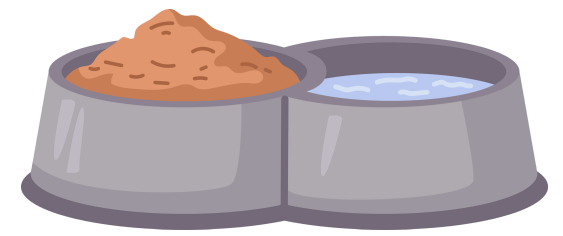
4 TIPS FOR KEEPING WILDLIFE SAFE CATS AND WILDLIFE

CAT FOOD

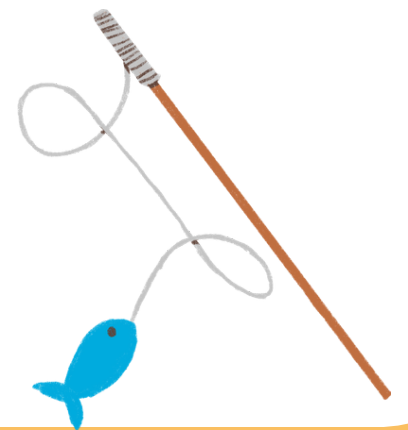
- Cats who eat cat food do not hunt as much
- Hungry cats hunt a lot. Feed your cat so they are not hungry and do not hunt a lot

PLAY TIME

- Cats that play do not hunt as much
- Some cats hunt because they enjoy it
- Play with your cat instead of letting your cat hunt

COLLARS AND BELLS

- Cats with bells on their collars make noise when they move.
- The sound lets other animals know the cat is near
- Placing a collar and bell on your cat can help reduce their hunting ability

KEEP CATS INSIDE

- Cats are most active at night and lots of native animals come out at night!
- If cats are inside at night, they cannot hunt the wildlife.

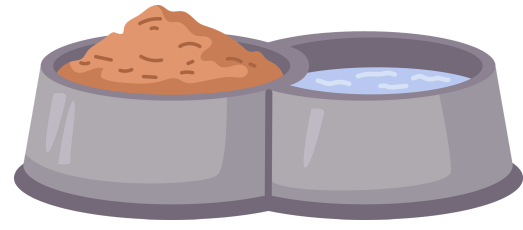

FEED CATS

Cats that are hungry hunt a lot - killing lots of animals to eat!
Feed your cat at home to help reduce hunting

PLAY

Did you know.... Cats also hunt for fun???
Cats that play do not hunt as much
Play with your cat at home instead of letting them go hunt cat.

KEEP CATS INSIDE

Cats are most active at night and lots of wildlife comes out at night!
If cats are inside at night, they cannot hunt the wildlife.

COLLAR & BELL

Cats with bells on their collars make noise when they move.
The sound lets other animals know the cat is near, making it harder for them to hunt.
Placing a collar and bell on your cat can help reduce their hunting ability
