

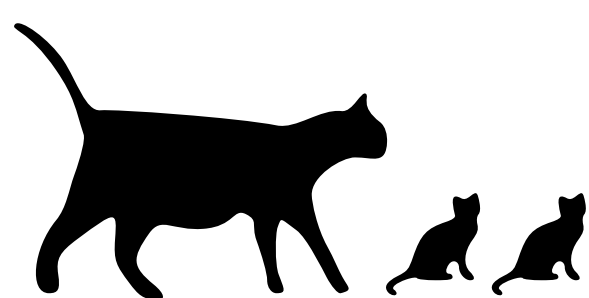
DESEXING *your cat*

Desexed cats live longer and healthier lives

What is desexing?

Desexing is a surgical procedure to remove the reproductive organs from male and female cats. In male cats the procedure is called 'castration', in female cats the procedure is called 'speying'. After desexing, your cat will no longer be able to breed.

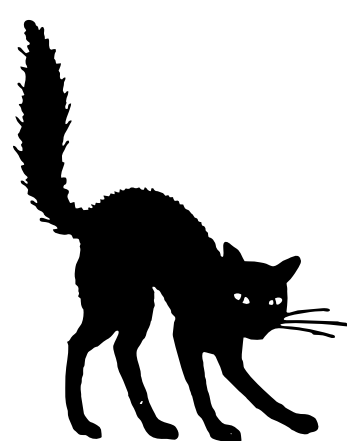
The benefits of desexing



PREVENT
unwanted litters



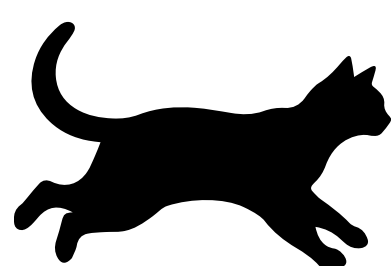
Desexing cats stops them from breeding and having kittens



REDUCE fighting



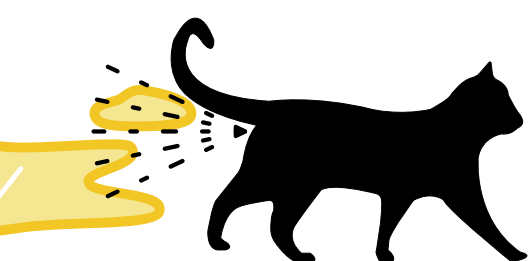
Desexed cats are less likely to fight with other cats.



REDUCE roaming



Desexed cats are less likely to roam and will spend more time at home.



REDUCE spraying



Desexed cats are less likely to spray urine - which is very smelly!
